

NIFT B.Des MCQ Mini Mock Test 01 — Offline Worksheet

Creative Ability Test (CAT), Questions 16–17 (40 marks) — Southwide original practice content, not a full official-pattern replica. The online mini mock covers the 15-question General Ability Test (GAT). The two CAT tasks below require hand-drawn/visual design responses that the website's engine doesn't score yet, so they're provided here as a downloadable worksheet with rubrics for self-assessment or mentor review.

Creative Ability Test

Q16. Visual storytelling — 20 marks

Create a three-frame sequence showing a scarf transforming into a useful object during unexpected rain. The transformation must be understandable without explanatory text.

Rubric: idea 5; sequence clarity 5; composition 4; drawing skill 3; originality 3.

Q17. Product and colour concept — 20 marks

Design a shopping bag for a weekend craft market. It must carry fragile handmade objects, fold flat when empty and use no plastic laminate. Show the structure, closure, handles and a two-colour graphic concept.

Rubric: function 5; creativity 4; material awareness 4; colour/graphic use 3; presentation 4.

Self-assessment guidance

There is no single correct answer for CAT tasks — use the rubric points above to self-assess or have a mentor/teacher review your work. Strong responses typically show a clear, original idea communicated visually with confident linework and thoughtful use of the given constraints (fold-flat, no plastic laminate, understandable without text, etc.).
